This Sunday's Sermon

The Lion's Roar Against Our Shame **John 4:1-30**

The first of a four-part series that ends on Palm Sunday, entitled ***Jesus: The Untamed Lion of Judah.***

At a well in the heat of the day, Jesus steps directly into a woman's shame—not to expose her, but to free her. He offers Himself as *living water*, bringing the forgiveness and new identity her heart longed for. The same Jesus still meets us in our hidden places with transforming grace. Join us as we discover how the Lion of Judah breaks into our ordinary lives to give us the life only He can give.

Throughout Lent, we'll remember how easily we settle for a safe, agreeable Jesus. But the true Jesus calls us to seek His kingdom and His righteousness, allowing His holiness and goodness to change us into who we were meant to be.

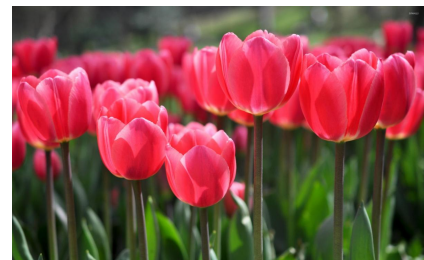
